**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 171 "INCOME
TAX" OF THE SEBRING CODIFIED ORDINANCES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sebring has retained the services of Jim Nuesser to revise the Sebring Income Tax Ordinance in accordance with state law changes; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a comprehensive review and revision with Amendments to conform the Sebring Income Tax Ordinance with state law; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of Council to adopt the attached Amendments to the Sebring Income Tax Ordinance in order to bring its income tax ordinance into conformity with state law.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
SEBRING, MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That Chapter 171 of the Sebring Codified Ordinances is hereby amended in its entirety in accordance with attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten and restated in this section.

Section 2. The effective date of this Ordinance for purposes of income tax compliance shall be January 1, 2005 provided said Ordinance is adopted within the calendar year of 2005.




121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, all pursuant to Section 3.11 of the Charter of the Village of Sebring.


