



YWCA Programs Available for Residents of Sebring & Beloit



Diaper Bank

- Diapers are available free of charge
- We have all sizes: Newborn, 1-6, and sizes M, L, XL Pull-ups
- Must fill out intake and provide ID to receive 50 diapers and 1 pack of wipes
- Each family is eligible for diapers once per month



Gas Cards

- If you are in need of transportation assistance, gas cards are available
- Must fill out intake and provide drivers license to receive a card
- Individuals are eligible for a gas card once per six months



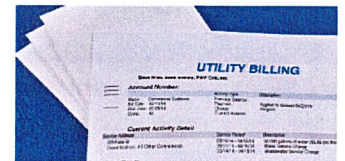
Laundry Detergent

- Laundry detergent powder is available free of charge
- Must fill out intake and provide ID to receive 3 cups of laundry powder (this can do 48-96 loads)
- Each family is eligible for detergent once per month



Utility Bill Assistance

- Utility bill assistance is available while funds last
- Must fill out intake, provide ID, and provide bill
- Each family is eligible for utility bill assistance once per calendar year

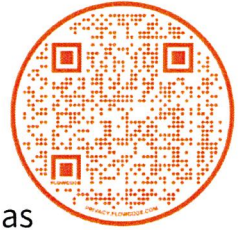
Trojan Care Closet

- Run by donations; always accepting clothing in good condition



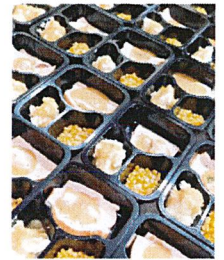
Transitional Housing
